#### Preparatory three Steps to the Sixteen-step Pūjā

#### 1. Light a lamp





#### 2. Offer flowers chanting

दीपज्योतिः परं ब्रह्म दीपज्योतिर्जनार्दनः । दीपो मे हरतु पापं दीपज्योतिर्नमोऽस्तु ते ॥

dīpajyotiḥ param brahma dīpajyotir janārdanaḥ dīpo me haratu pāmam dīpajyotir namo'stu te

The light of the lamp stands for *Brahman*, the unmanifest truth as well as for Lord *Viṣṇu* (in his manifest form). Let the light of lamp remove my *pāpas*, results of omissions and commissions.

#### 3.a. Ācamanam

Take a sip of water after chanting each of the following mantras:

ॐ अच्युताय नमः ।

om achutāya namaḥ

Salutations unto the Lord who is imperishable.

ॐ अनन्ताय नमः ।

om anantāya namaḥ

Salutations unto the Lord who is limitless.

ॐ गोविन्दाय नमः ।

om govindāya namaḥ

Salutations unto Lord Govinda.

#### 3.b. Guru Dhyānam

गुरुर्बह्मा गुरुर्विष्णुः गुरुदेवो महेश्वरः ।

गुरुस्साक्षात् परं ब्रह्म तस्मे श्रीगुरवे नमः ॥

gurubrahmā gururviṣṇuḥ gururdevo maheśvaraḥ gurussākṣāt paraṁ brahma tasmai śrīgurave namaḥ

The *guru* is *Brahmā*, the *guru* is *Viṣṇu*, the *guru* is *Maheśvara*. The *guru* is ultimate truth. Unto that *guru* my prostration.

## शुक्लाम्बरधरं विष्णुं शशिवर्णं चतुर्भुजम् । प्रसन्नवदनं ध्यायेत् सर्वविद्योपशान्तये ॥ १॥

śuklāmbaradharam viṣṇum śaśivarṇam caturbhujam prasannavadanam dhyāyet sarvavighnopaśāntaye

May one meditate upon Lord *Gaṇeśa*, who wears the white garment, who is all pervasive, who has a bright complexion (like a full moon), who has four hands (representing all power), who has an ever smiling face (or an elephant face), for the removal of all obstacles.

Oh Lord Ganesha, One with a curved trunk, a large body, and a brilliance equal to a billion suns, may You always make all my undertakings free from obstacles.

vasudevasutum devam kamsacāṇūramardanam devakīparamānandam kṛṣṇam vande jagadgurum

### श्री हनुमान




