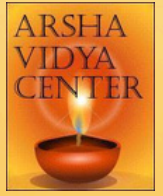

## Swami Sakshatkritananda

**I am satyam jñānam anantam brahma**



Swamiji will explore the topic of “I am satyam jñānam anantam brahma” — An Enquiry based on Taittiriya Upanishad. He will cover the subtle aspects of the unfolding of the realization.

Swami Sakshatkritananda (Swami Sakshatji) is a senior monk of the Arsha Vidya Gurukulam, Rishikesh, and a long-standing disciple of Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati. Known for his clarity, depth, and traditional teaching style, he has taught Vedānta for several decades in India and abroad. Swamiji is widely respected for presenting Upaniṣadic wisdom in a precise, methodical, and contemplative manner, while staying fully rooted in the sampradāya. He currently serves as a senior teacher at the Rishikesh Gurukulam, guiding students in Vedānta, meditation, and traditional living.
