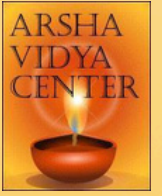

Selective Verses from Panchadashi, Dvaita Viveka



The Panchadashi is the magnum opus of a highly erudite scholar of Vedanta in medieval India by the name of Swami Vidyananda. It is a treatise on some of the main topics in Vedanta shastra and unfolds the vision of oneness lucidly and effortlessly. The jiva suffers due to living in a subjective world of one's own preferences and prejudices, and is unable to live objectively. One's raga-dvesha based subjectivity is the cause of all misunderstandings, and sorrow. In fact, not knowing the truth of oneself leads to a pileup of misapprehension of the nature of oneself, the jagat, and īśvara. In this chapter, Swami Vidyananda lays bare the causes of this subjectivity and unfolds how it leads to the bondage and sorrow.

Swamini Svatmavidyananda Saraswati is a senior disciple of Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati and a highly respected teacher in the Arsha Vidya sampradāya.
